However we are grateful that QER's investors continue to advance the project and recognise that the big picture is a very long term one.

In 2016 therefore, QER will be continuing to progress our project in three main areas: refining the processing technology; improving the project design to enhance its appeal to investors when the market turns around; and progressing project approvals.

Our technical development efforts will be focussed on construction and operation of our Retort Feed Test Unit here in Gladstone as I've discussed previously in this column. Our engineers in Brisbane are also looking at a range of other potential improvements to increase efficiency and minimise the greenhouse gas footprint of the project.

The Brisbane team are also looking at how we might structure and phase a commercial project to improve returns and therefore attract finance as soon as possible as the market recovers.

Finally we will be working with the State Government to help define the policy framework in which our project can progress. Once this is finalised we'll be able to complete and submit our Environmental Impact Statement for assessment.

In the meantime, we'll continue to contribute as a proud part of the Gladstone community and look forward to again supporting and participating in wonderful community events such as Ecofest and the Harbour Festival.
