As I mentioned before Christmas, we are building the unit to test and refine a new retort feed arrangement at scale, so we can lock the improved design into QER's commercial plant concept.

We are very happy to be working closely with local contractors Oaka construction on the civil works and Xtreme engineering on the fabrication and construction of the plant (which is being fabricated in their local workshop). A number of other local subcontractors are also involved. It's good to be able to get local firms involved in this sort work at time when the local economy is pretty quiet.

Soon we'll be seeing some big loads transported to our site from town and we'll keep you in the loop as the project progresses!
